Specifications:

Work shall commence on or before May 1 of each year. Once work begins, the contractor shall daily (weather permitting) have one or more sweepers working towards job completion.

Night sweeping is permissible and encouraged. Sweeping in residential areas is allowed from 6:00 am to 10:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.

Sweeping on the right-of-way is straight across driveway openings. At street/road intersections, the contractor shall sweep the entire radii.

Dump sites shall be provided within reasonable distances from sweeping areas and the contractor shall be responsible for transport to these sites.

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The contractor shall provide associated traffic control for the safety of the public and the contractor's employees.

Insurance:

Contractor shall purchase from and maintain in a company or companies lawfully authorized to do business in Michigan such insurance that will protect Contractor from claims set forth below which may arise out of or result from Contractor's operations under the contract and for which Contractor may be legally liable, whether such operations be by Contractor or by a subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them, or by anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable:

Certificates of insurance with the following coverage and minimum limits must be on file with the Emmet County Road Commission before work begins. Please note the additional insured wording (noted with an *).

1. Comprehensive General Liability *

a.	Contractual Liability	Bodily Injury: \$500,000 each occurrence
	Completed Operations	Bodily Injury: \$500,000 aggregate
	Property Damage	\$250,000 each occurrence
	Property Damage	\$250,000 aggregate

OR

b. Commercial General Liability * Same coverage as 1a \$500,000 each occurrence \$500,000 aggregate

*The following wording must be added to the certificate of insurance: "The Emmet County Road Commission, its commissioners, and employees are listed as additional insured under the general liability."

- 2. Claims under workers' or workmen's compensation disability benefit and other similar employee benefit acts which are applicable to the work to be performed;
- 3. Claims for damages because of bodily injury, occupational sickness or disease, or death of any person other than Contractor's employees.
- 4. Claims for damages because of bodily injury, death of a person or property damage arising out of ownership, maintenance, or use of a motor vehicle.

Non-performance or unsatisfactory performance shall be grounds for termination. Ten working days written notice shall be given.
