ENGINEER-MANAGER'S REPORT: Gutowski gave an update on the results of the Chip Seal trial and also reported the following:

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT: Beckman reported on the following:

- Pleasantview Road, 3.5 miles Cold In-Place Recycling. This is a BIA project with an Ultra-thin to be placed over this on Thursday. Beckman discussed the process in detail delineating pros and cons. Gutowski noted this project will be going to Robinson Road instead of Tower Road.
- North Conway Road reconstruction project. This is a federal aid project being affected by the
 current union lockout with some progress still occurring. Zulski expressed concern with deep
 ditches in some places. Beckman commented on restoration plans that are to be done by
 October 15, culverts to be placed next week and a paving timeline is unknown at this point.
- Reed Road Bridge Project deck was set vesterday and paving is to be done next week.
- Pickerel Lake Road Bridge Project piling is currently being driven.
- Woodland Road Bridge piling will begin next week.
- Finalizing projects with punch lists is occurring. Atkins Road punch list was discussed as well as what still needs to be completed.

EQUIPMENT SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Genson reported he plans to begin to pulling trucks for winter preparation and he also thanked the Board for hiring the last couple of truck drivers.

ROAD FOREMAN'S REPORT: Zmikly reported new truck drivers are being trained in Levering and the crew has been completing MDOT work before the end of the month. Beckman also stated the Conway crew has been working for MDOT on US 31 at Rosada.
